#### Within the project the following activities are supposed:

**Target market research.** In the project research has been surveyed 150 – 200 managers of catering companies from each member state in order to identify and to explore issues of the target groups and their needs and to define possible solutions to small and micro hospitality companies management improvement. **E-environment training program.** In order to improve and optimize management processes for small and micro businesses catering companies within the project will be developed a training program, lectures, manual and standardized document packages in e-environment.

**Testing of e-environment training program and materials.** During product testing phase employees of small/micro catering companies will be able to apply for the training cycle and to get free training materials and certificate for the course acquirement. Testing will be held in five member states (Latvia, Spain, Turkey, Italy and Slovakia).
